DIRECTIVE TO THE PS/ST FOR FUNDING OF KARAMOJA PEACE AND TECHNOLOGY UNIVERSITY (KAPATU) PROJECT IN THE FY 2025/2026

Reference is made to the above subject matter.

Sir, at the meeting of Members of Parliament, LC5 Chairpersons, Mayors of Cities and Municipalities and Leaders of business communities from West Nile, Acholi, Lango and Karamoja (WALK) Sub Regions, held today 24th December, 2024 at Acholi Inn Hotel, Gulu City, who also attended the historic launch of MIAU in Gulu City, officiated by your Good Self, it was resolved as follows:

1. THAT H.E. President Yoweri Kaguta Museveni be thanked as Founding Chancellor and for convening a Cabinet meeting on 16/12/2024 in which the Cabinet passed a decision to make available in the national budget in

the Financial Year 2025/2026, Uganda Shillings 180 billion for the establishment of Karamoja Peace and Technology University (KAPATU).

- 2. THAT H.E. Maj. Jessica Alupo, the Vice President of Uganda be thanked as Deputy Chancellor and for providing guidance and for ably representing H.E. the President.
- 3. THAT Gen Salim Saleh is asked to direct the PS/ST to include the UGX 180 Billion approved by Cabinet in the Buget Frame Work Paper 2025/2026 for inclusion in the budget 2025/2026.

Sir, as you agree, KAPATU is a Unique, High Impact and Strategic Government Intervention, that speaks to the vision of H.E. the President on the transformation of Karamoja and the Greater Ateker Communities.

We believe that your directive and close follow-up action will embolden the PS/ST to restrain the Ministry of finance officials from the usual habit of using technicalities and bureaucratic procedures to delay and frustrate implementation of noble Government decisions.
